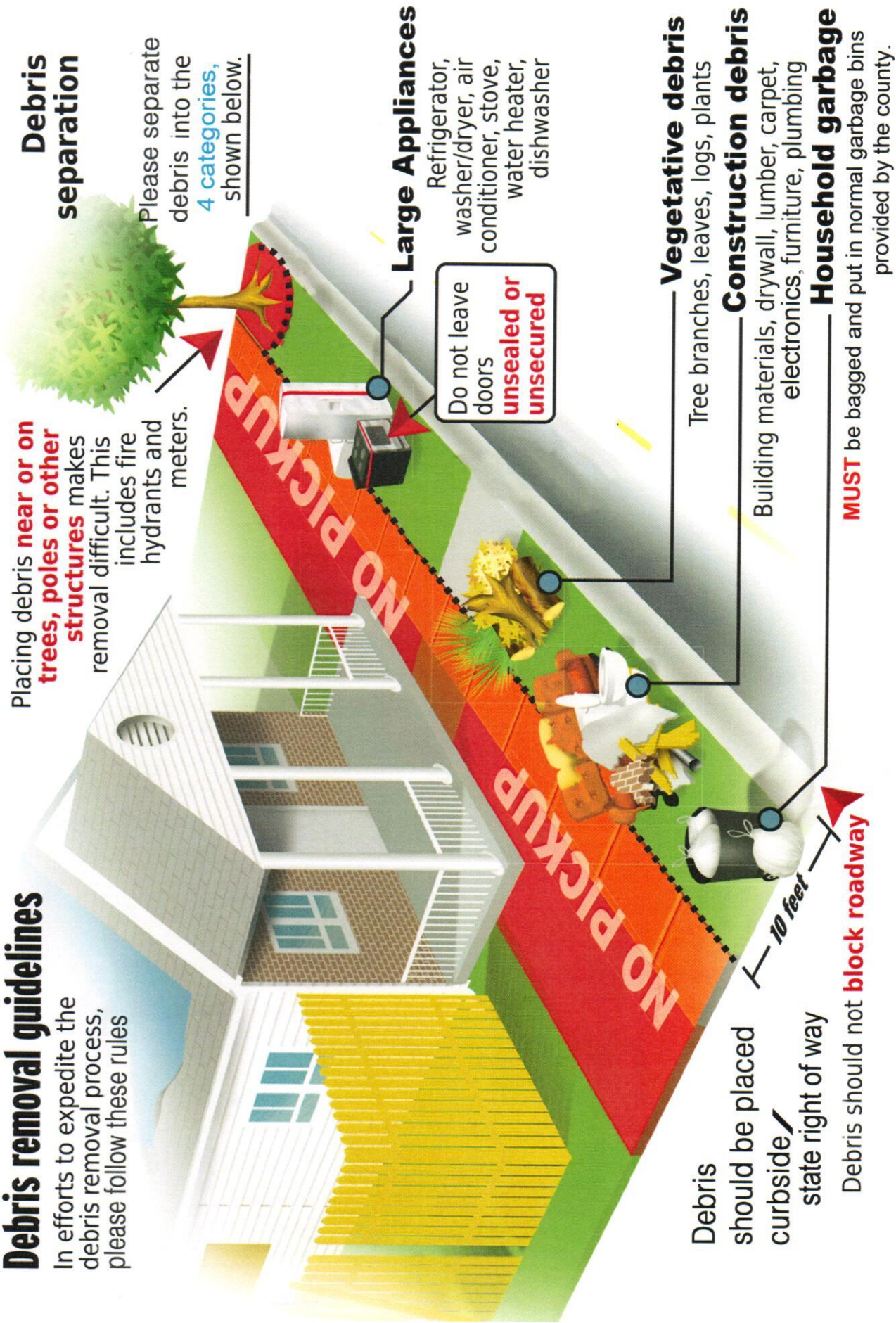
Debris removal guidelines

In efforts to expedite the debris removal process, please follow these rules

Placing debris **near or on trees, poles or other structures** makes removal difficult. This includes fire hydrants and meters.

Debris separation

Please separate debris into the **4 categories, shown below.**



Large Appliances

Refrigerator, washer/dryer, air conditioner, stove, water heater, dishwasher

Do not leave doors **unsealed or unsecured**

Vegetative debris

Tree branches, leaves, logs, plants

Construction debris

Building materials, drywall, lumber, carpet, electronics, furniture, plumbing

Household garbage

MUST be bagged and put in normal garbage bins provided by the county.

Debris

should be placed curbside/
state right of way

Debris should not **block roadway**
